

Aftercare After Removal

1. Initial Cleaning & Care

Keep the treated area clean. Avoid water contact for the first 48 hours. After showering, apply a very small amount of baby Vaseline using a cotton swab.

2. Daily Care After 48 Hours

After the first 48 hours, apply a very small amount of baby Vaseline once a day.

3. Cleaning with Cooled Boiled Water

The next day, clean the area using a pad soaked in cooled boiled water, then apply Vaseline again very sparingly.

4. After Healing (About 1 Week)

After the area is healed (about one week), start applying Avène Cicalfate cream daily for one month, then discontinue.

5. Swelling

Swelling of the treated area is normal and can last 1–3 weeks, depending on each person's body and healing process.

6. General Aftercare Rules

- Keep the area clean at all times.
- Do not scratch, pick, or rub.
- Avoid swimming, sauna, hot tubs, and excessive sweating for at least 7 days.
- Do not apply makeup for at least 7 days.
- Sleep on your back with your head elevated for the first 3 nights.
- Expect redness, swelling, and tenderness for 3–5 days.
- 50–60% of the result depends on the practitioner, 40–50% on your aftercare.
- Follow the instructions carefully.

7. Contact in Case of Problems

If you experience excessive redness, swelling, pain, pus, or any other signs of infection, contact your technician immediately.
